Research sample

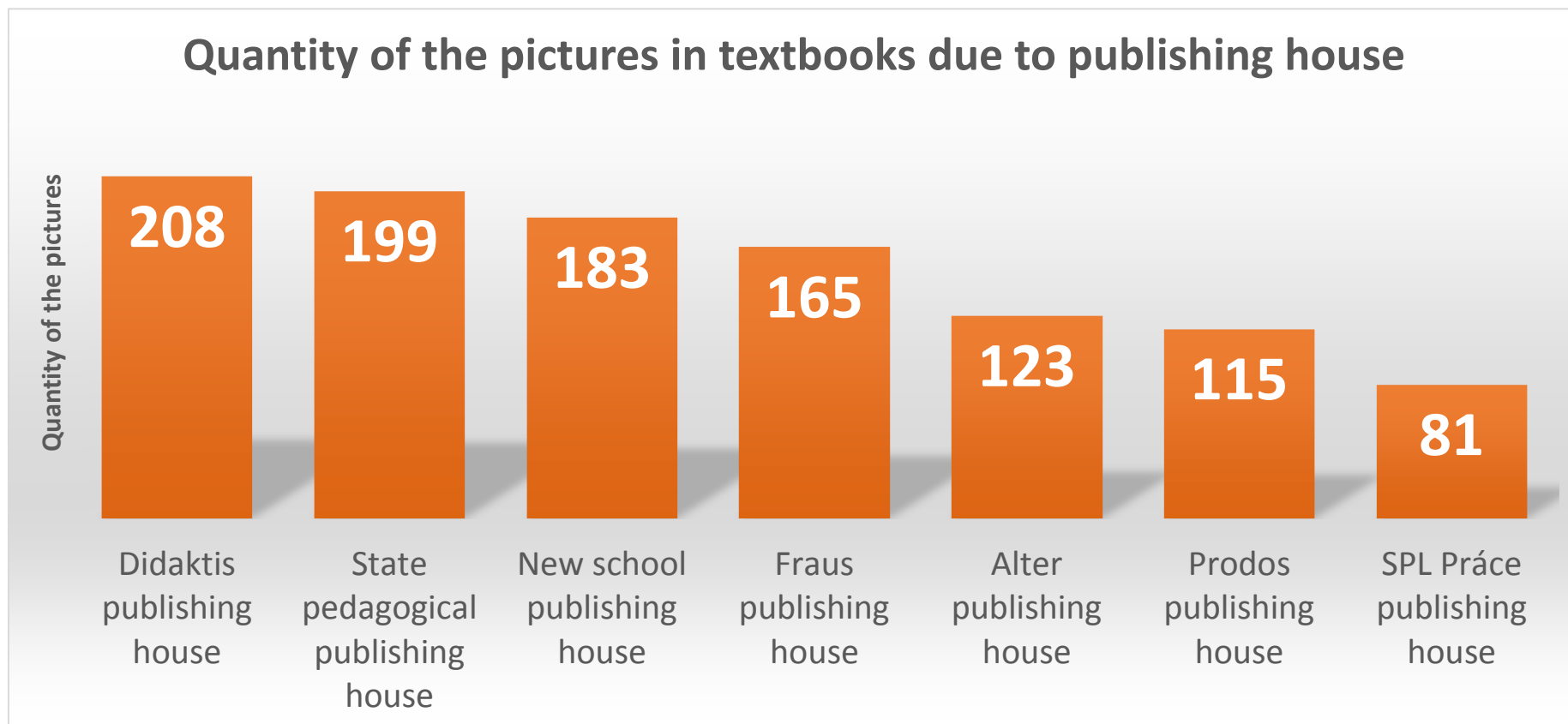
- **7 publishing houses:** Portál publishing house, Nová škola (New School publishing house), Prodos publishing house, SPN (State pedagogical publishing house), Fraus publishing house, Alter publishing house, SPL Práce publishing house
- **13 textbooks** (all recommended by Ministry of Education, Youth and Sports), for 4th and 5th class

Research methods

- The research method used was a **content analysis**.
- The number of images was determined by **frequency analysis**
- **statistical** calculations: **univariate data analysis** has been applied (measures of central tendency and variability).
- Correlations were calculated using the **Pearson correlation test** and **chi-square test** was also used to compare the number.

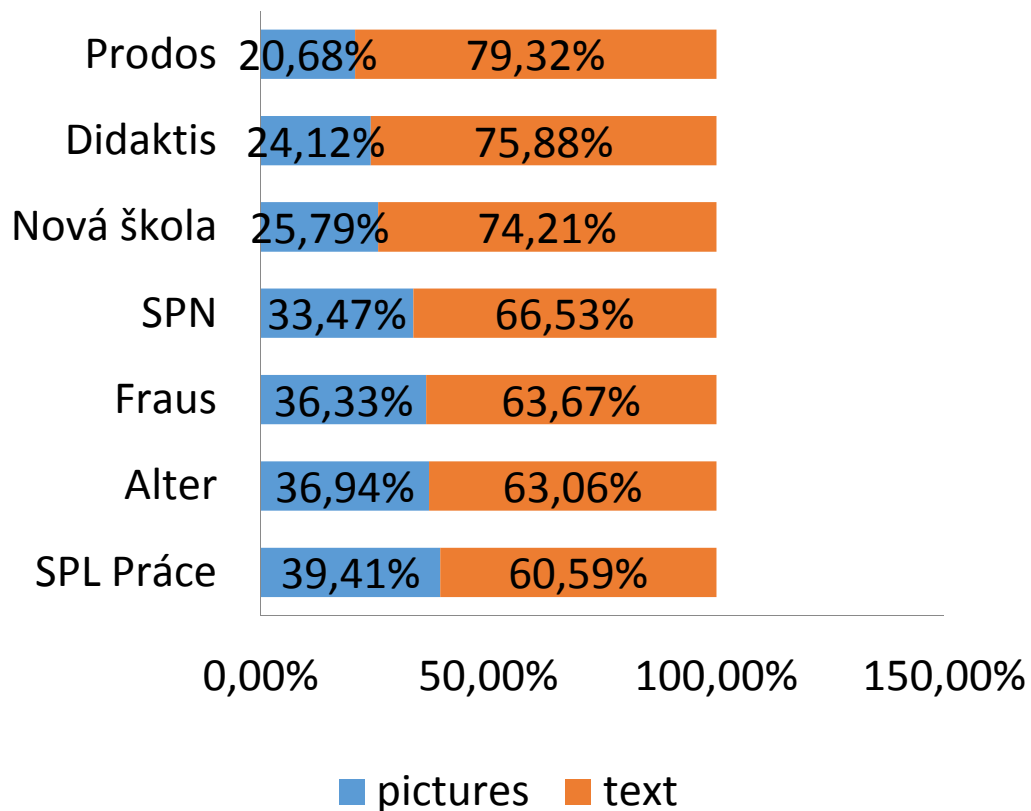

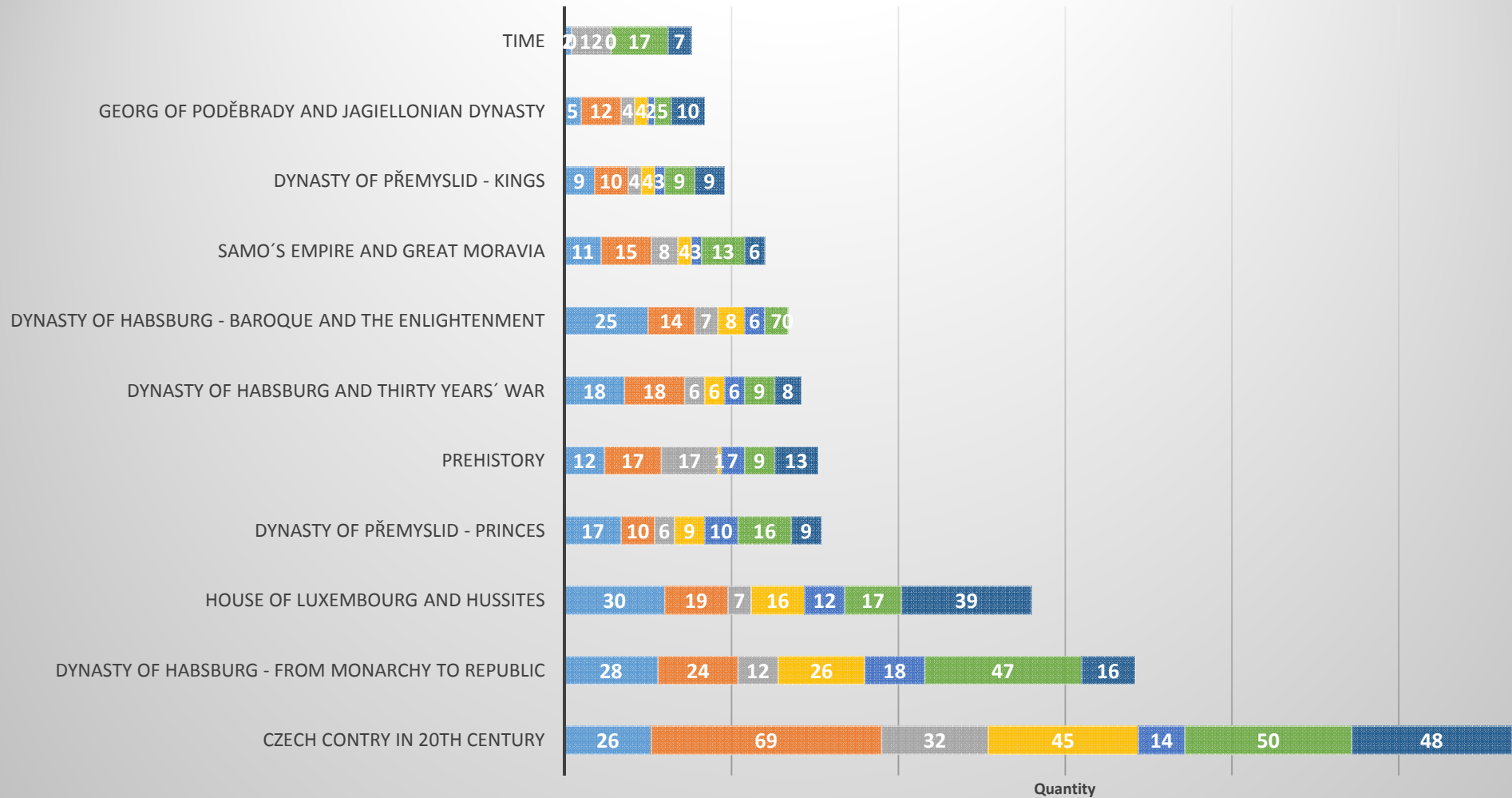
Area of visual component is directly proportional to the size of the thematic unit. All seven publishing houses a correlation coefficient (Pearson) more than 0,8.

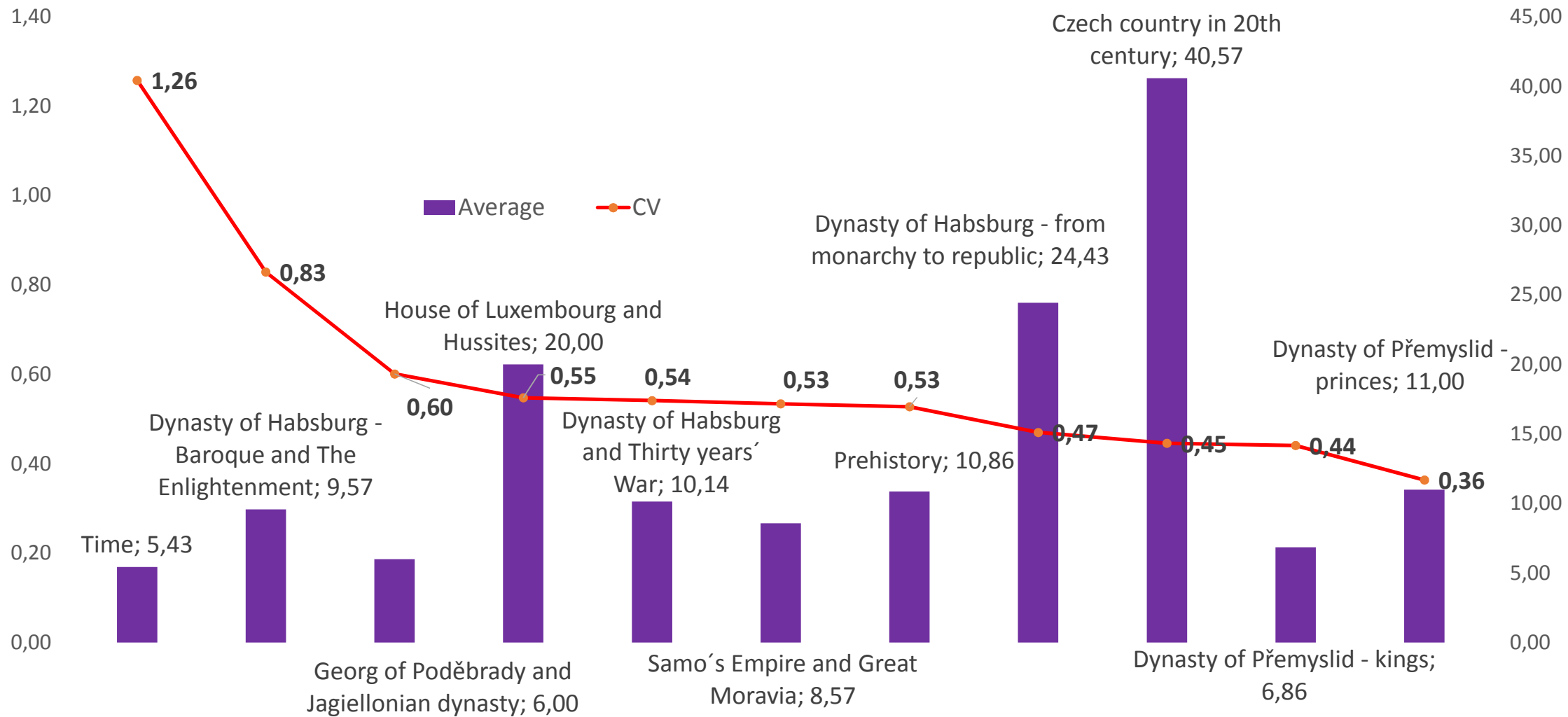
Quantity of the pictures due to historical topic

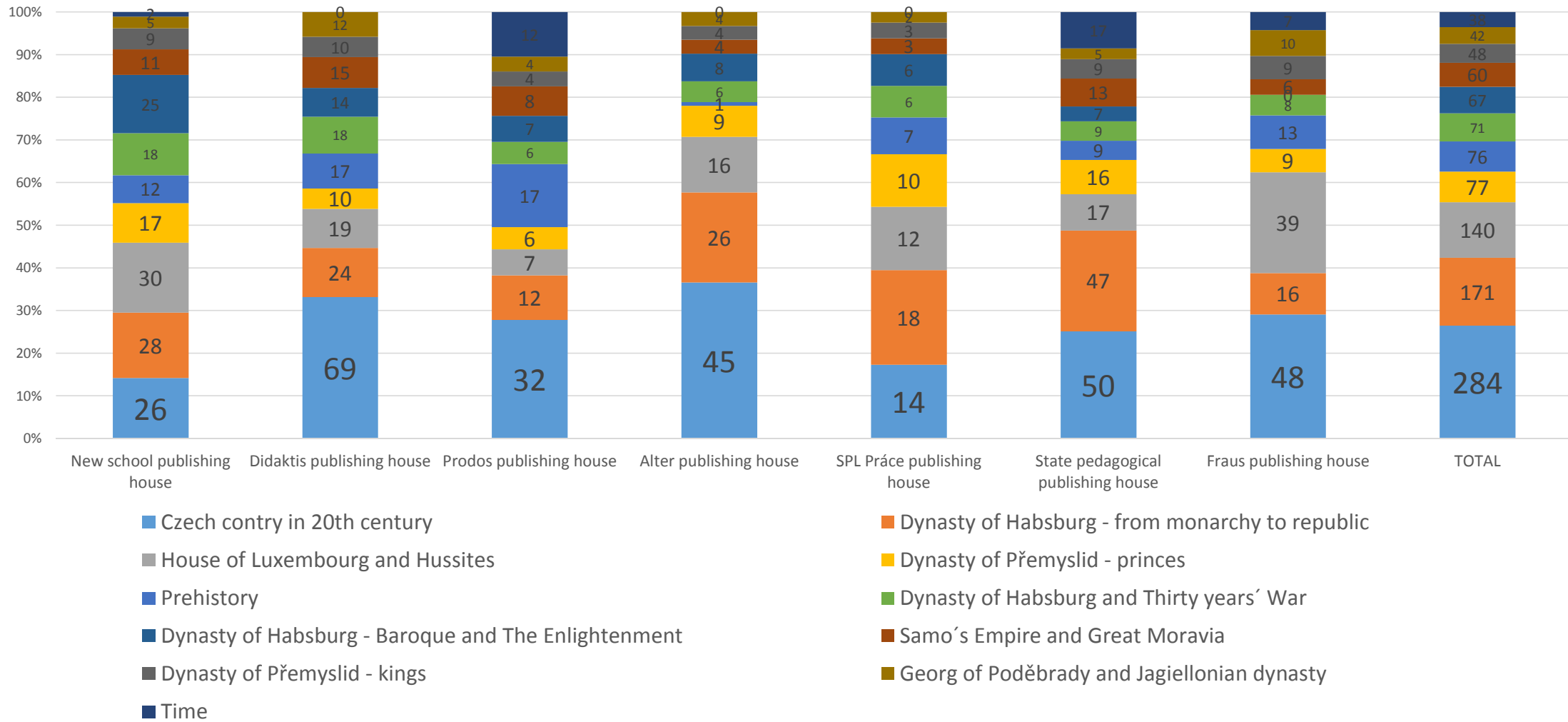

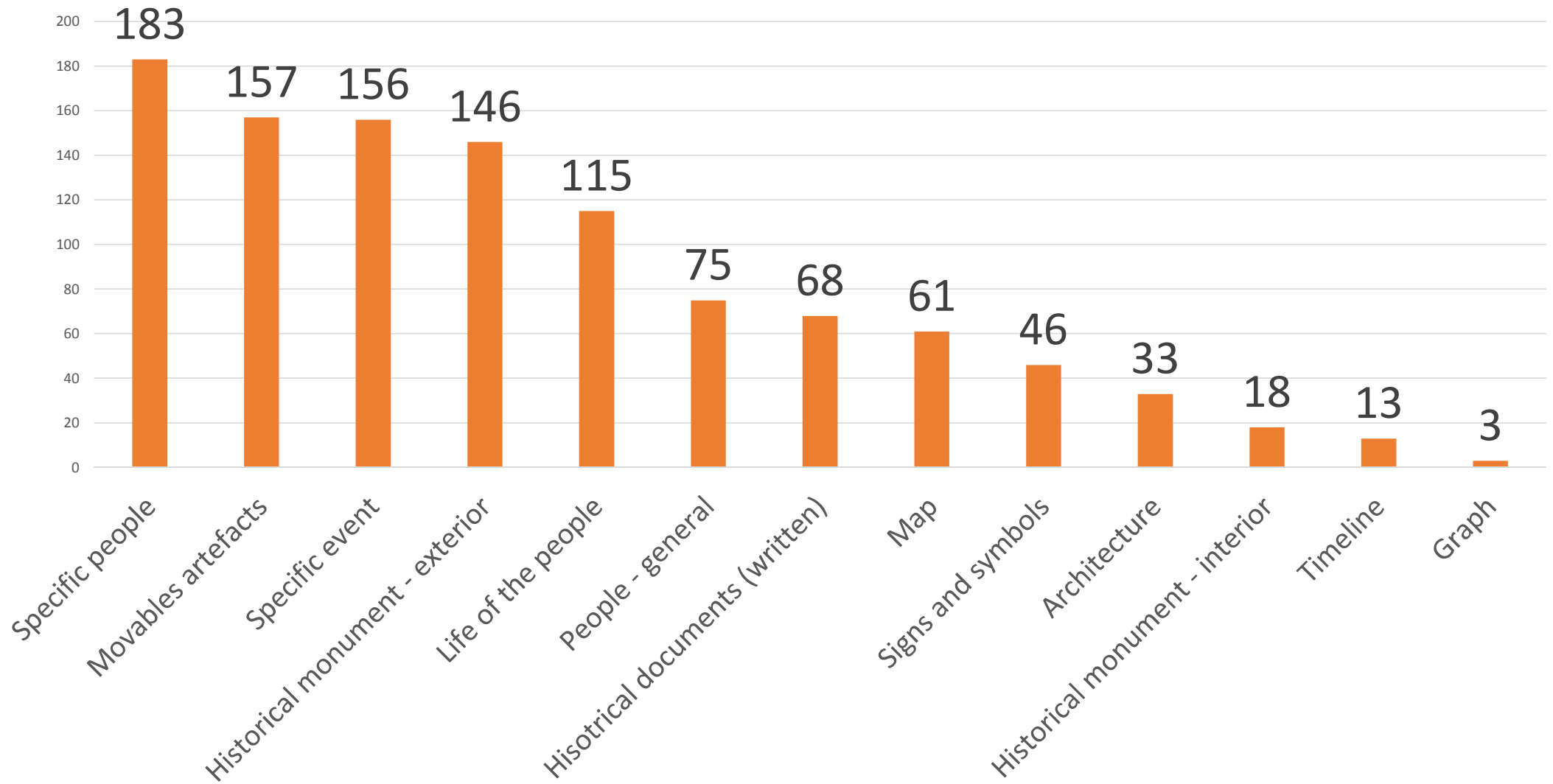

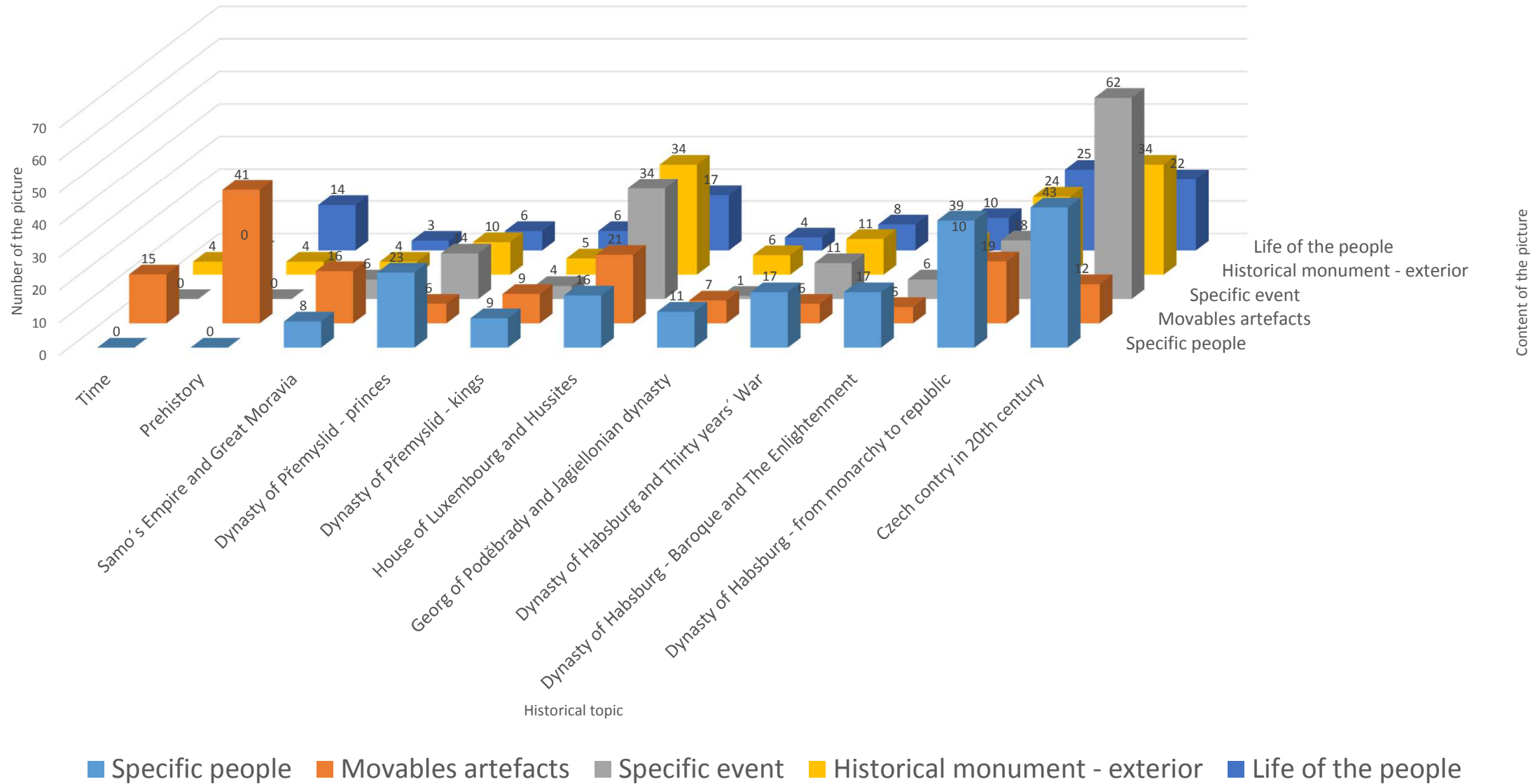

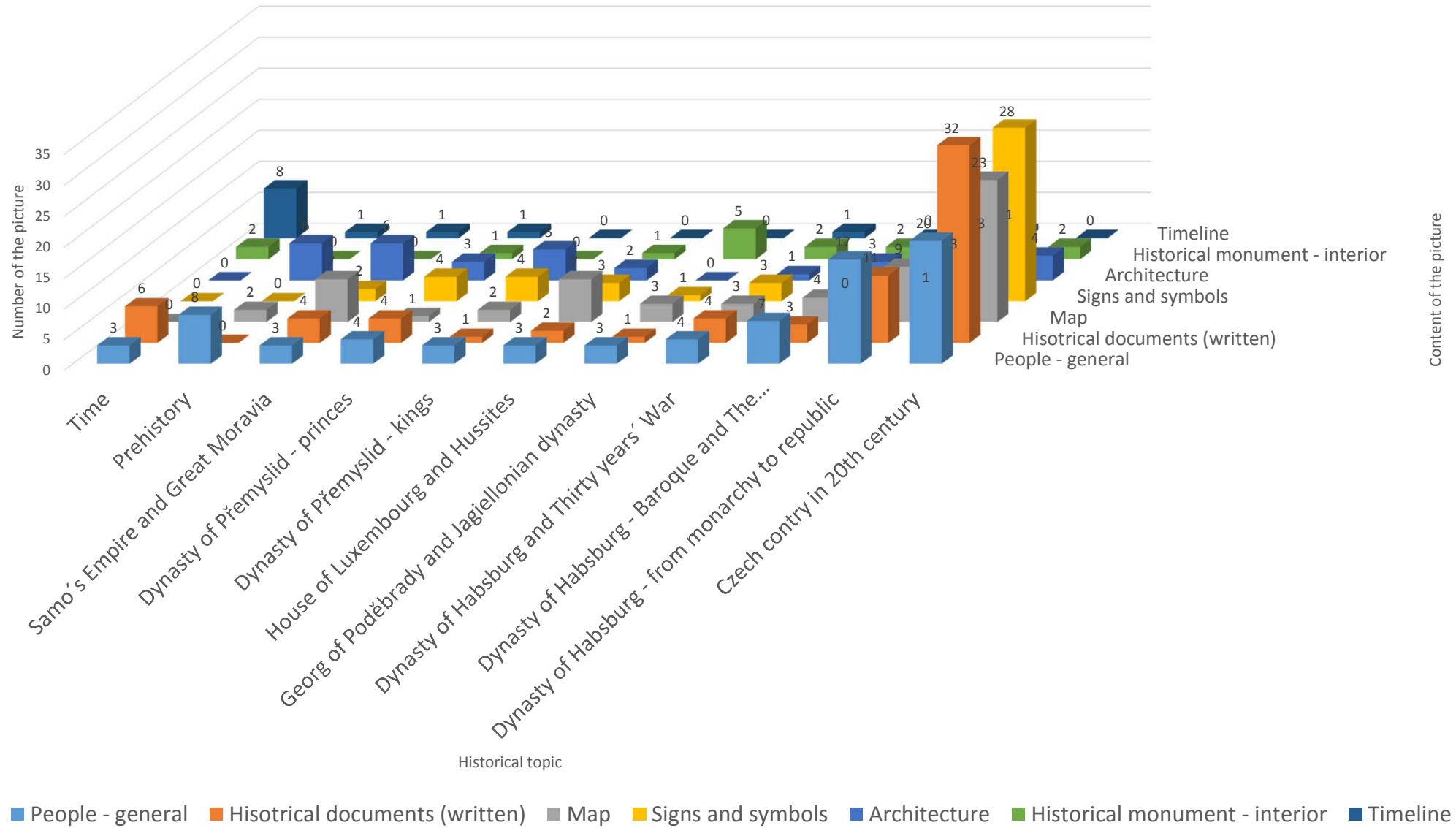


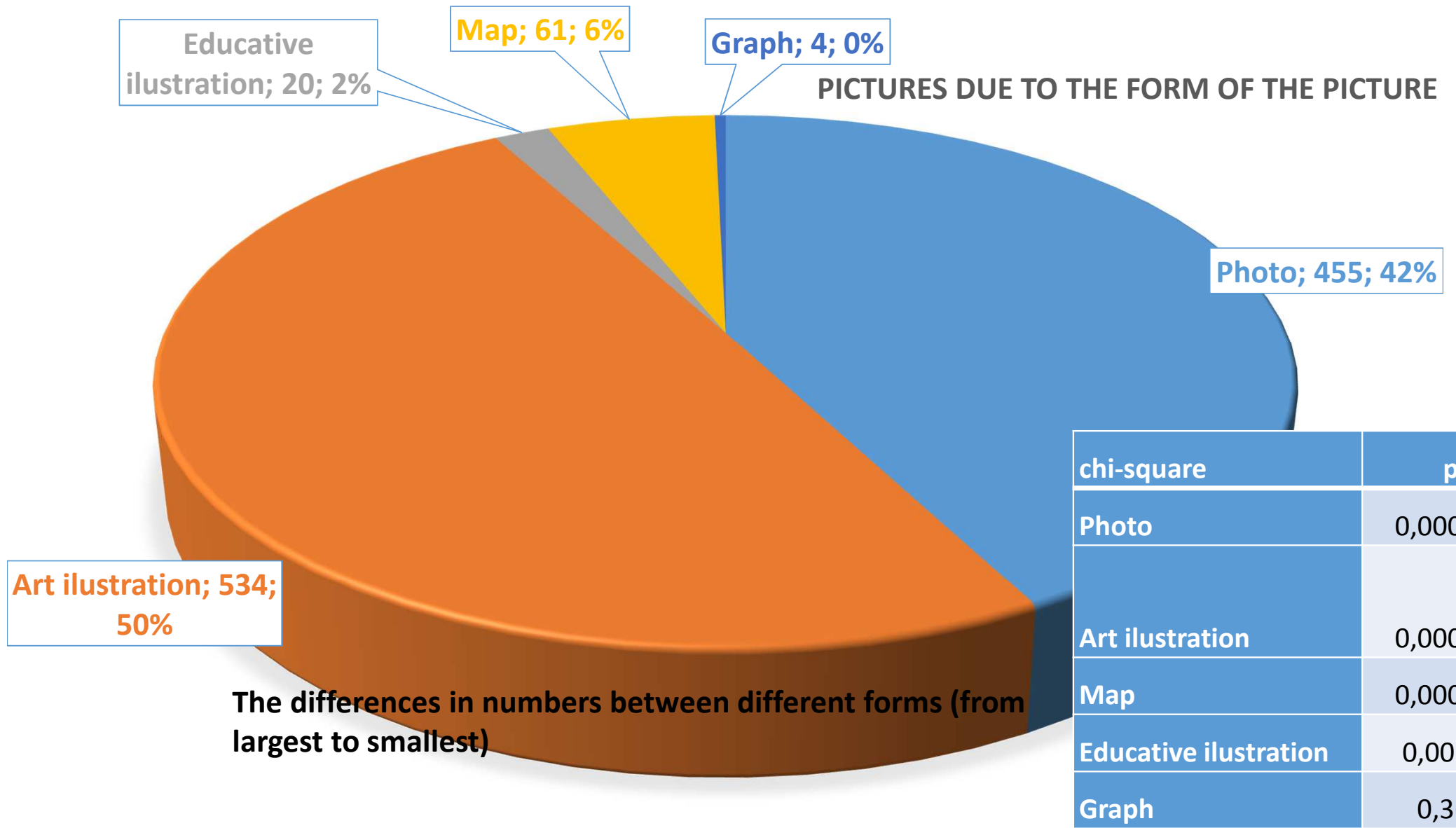

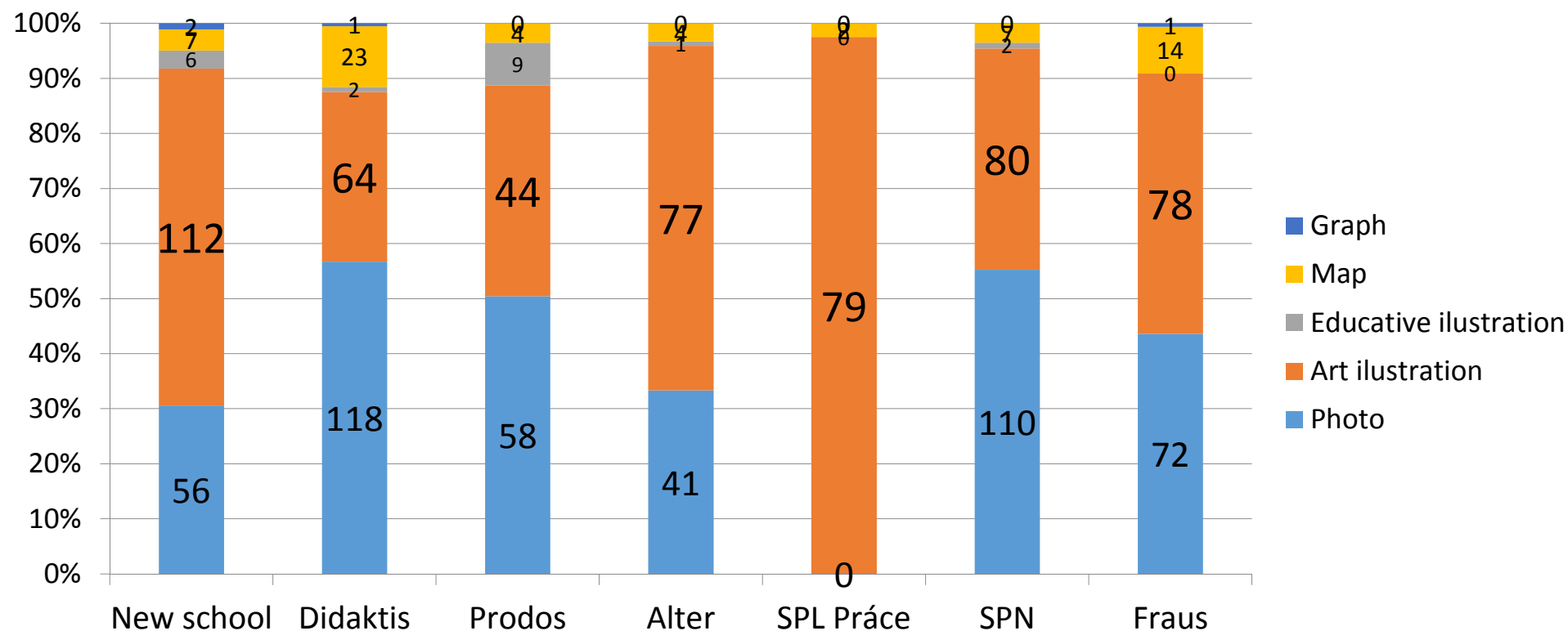


Content of the picture due to historical topic (quantity)- 7 less frequent



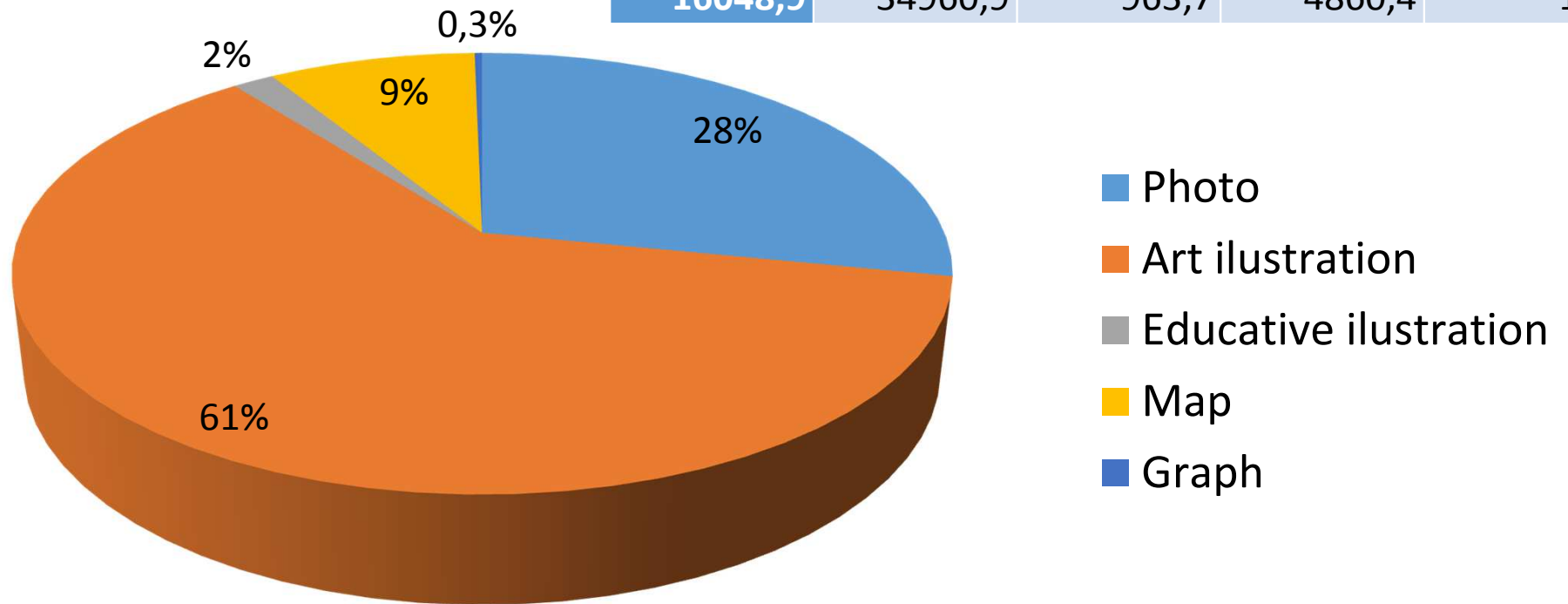


Form of the pictures due to publishing houses – nubmer (quantity)

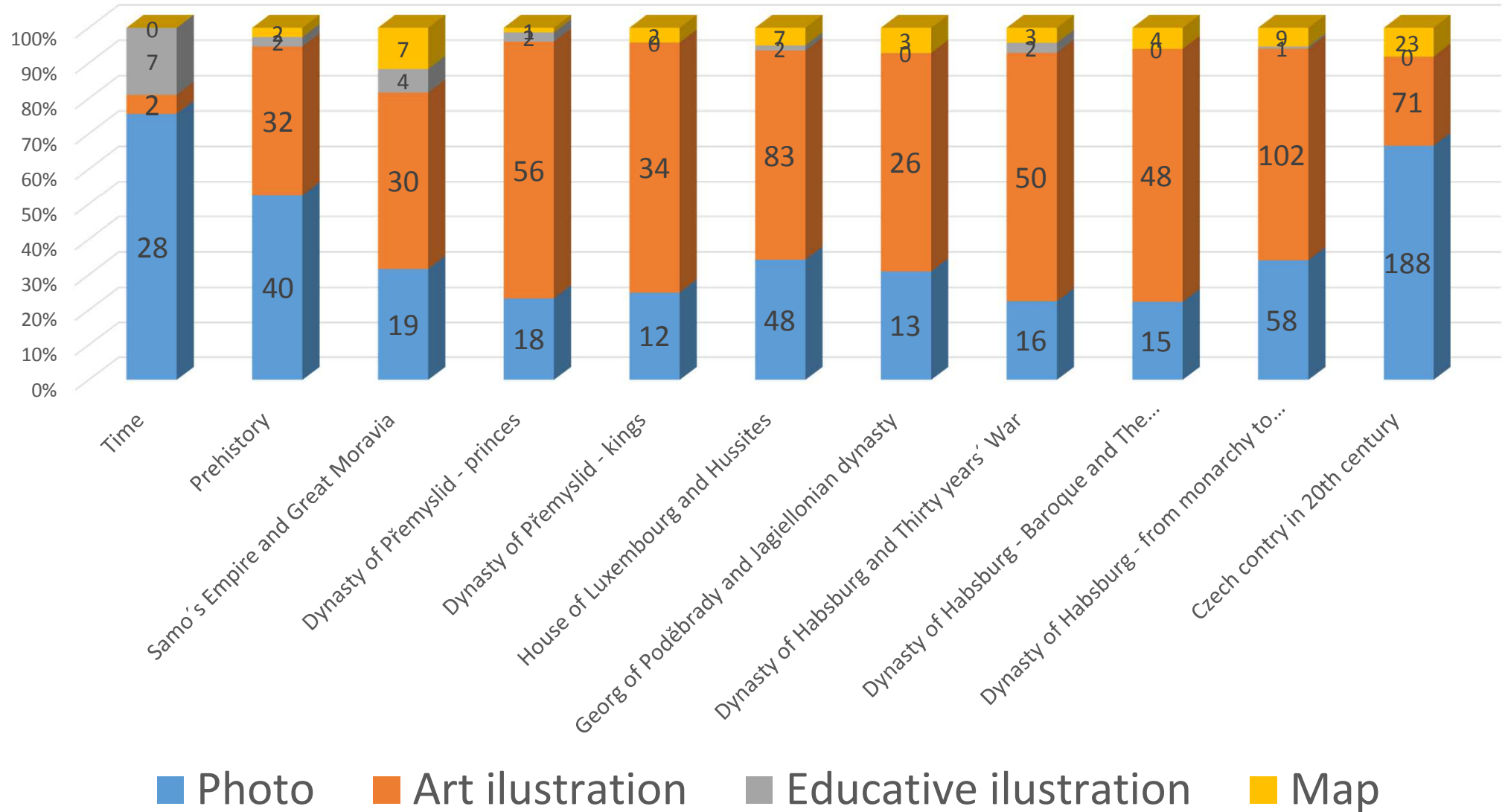


Area (cm²) due to form of the picture (all publishing h.)

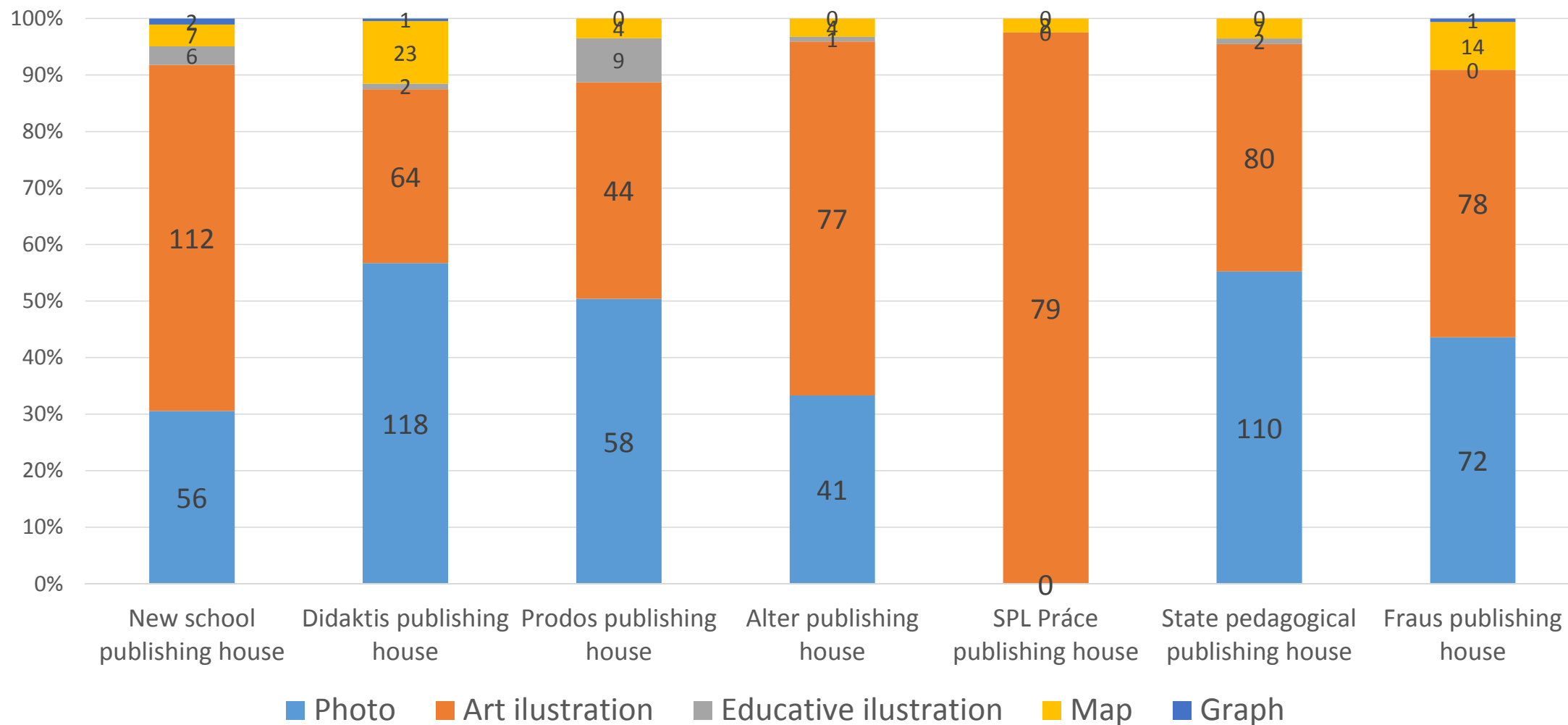

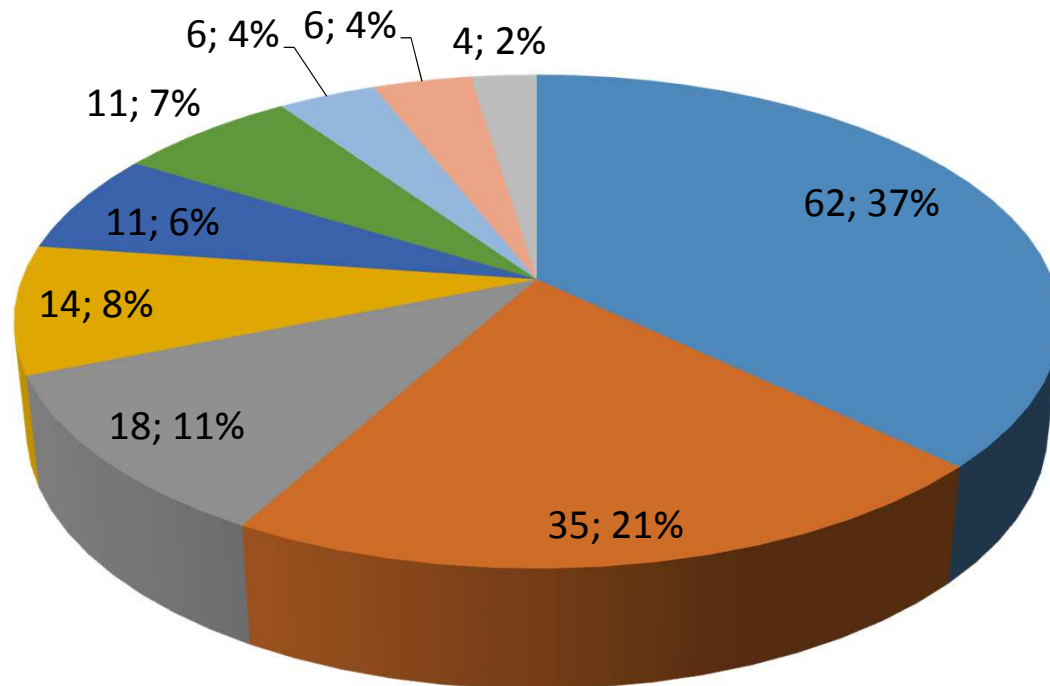
